

Prayer for Christian Unity

The week of prayer for Christian unity concludes this Sunday 25th January on the feast of the Conversion of Saint Paul. Seeing the increasing divisions within our families, within our society and our political and cultural life, we yearn more than ever for unity and peace.

This year, a telling example of ecumenism comes from what we might call the greater Middle East where we witness Christians of all denominations being mercilessly persecuted by radical Islamists and sharing in what Pope Francis has termed an "ecumenism of blood". Here the simple reality is that Islamic militants don't differentiate between Christian denominations.

Closer to home, we are happy to welcome the The Reverend Adrian Moran to Glanmire. The Reverend Adrian was appointed recently as priest-in-charge of the Church of Ireland Cobh and Glanmire Union. He was with us in St Joseph's Church when he preached the homily at the Advent Carol Service and we look forward to sharing worship opportunities in the years ahead.

True ecumenism begins with our turning in humility towards the cross and with our willingness to seek reconciliation. In this our ecumenical dialogue has, in the deepest sense, already reached its goal. It was in this spirit that Saint John Paul II wrote: "The witness of Christ borne even to the shedding of blood has become a common inheritance of Catholics, Orthodox, Anglicans and Protestants."
