At the Easter Vigil we enjoy listening to one of the most ancient and important hymns in the Church's tradition, the Exsultet. It literally means, Rejoice! In the early Church, the deacon would have known the Exsultet by heart. The honour of singing it was handed down from one generation to the next.

There are several images in the Exsultet that help us name our joy:

freedom from slavery;

an end to fear:

the triumph of life over death;

God's utter fidelity to his Son, Jesus.

The Exsultet sings that God has done this NOT because we have earned or deserved it, but simply because God loves his Son and loves us and loves his creation.

We call this Holy. Holiness belongs to God. Where God is there is holiness. God is very near.

As Christians, Easter joy is meant to mark our lives – though if some of us are truly joyful we should start by telling our faces about it!

Not that we can, or should, walk around perpetually smiling. Christian joy is more profound than that. It's about facing up to the most difficult and tragic moments in our lives knowing that we don't have to be afraid, that God's faithful love will see life win out over death. God is very close.
