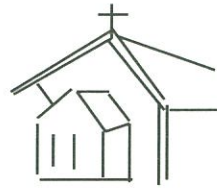

Sunday of the Word of God

In September 2019, Pope Francis launched the Sunday of the Word of God, to be celebrated annually on the 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, inviting local communities to find ways to “mark this Sunday with special solemnity” and suggested that the Bible be enthroned, “in order to focus the attention of the assembly on the normative value of God’s word”. Sunday of the Word of God will be celebrated this year on 26th January 2025. Enthronement of the Bible means setting it open in a place of honour in the sanctuary during Mass, allowing the congregation to venerate the Holy Word of God as given to us in Sacred Scriptures. At Mass we are fed from two tables: the table of the Word and the Table of the Eucharist, which nourish us spiritually for the week ahead. If we have a Bible at home we can enthrone it too, by opening it at the Gospel of Luke and lighting a candle to acknowledge God's presence with us in his Holy Word and giving thanks for it. The enthronement prayer will be printed on the mass leaflet on 26th January for us.
