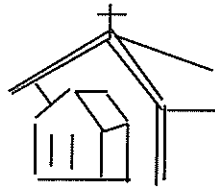

Reflection

A Homeless man who lived the Beatitudes

The following true event shows how genuinely Christian people treat each other. I found this example on you tube. It relates to two short videos about the generosity of a homeless man. This man was sitting on the pavement outside a department store in a big city. Two young students had seen him sitting there and they decided to give him a few slices of their pizza. He gratefully accepted it. A short time later another student came by and sat beside him and told him he was very hungry and would he mind giving him a slice of the pizza. The homeless man gave him a slice straight away without asking him why he needed it he just gave half of what he had been given himself. The young man thanked him sincerely and stood up and gave the man 200 dollars. The homeless got very upset and when the young man explained that he was part of young Christian group carrying out a social

experiment which was being filmed on candid camera the homeless man got even more upset and asked them not to show his face because his family who lived elsewhere did not know he was homeless. The other two came over to the homeless man and explained that they wanted to prove that those with the least amount were far more generous than those with a lot. The homeless man thanked them and thanked God and walked away. The homeless man's unexpected generosity had humbled the three young students. They have posted the short videos on you tube together with a plea for people to give money to the homeless. To date these short videos have had over 40 million hits.

Jubilee of Youth Pilgrimage to Rome

Bishop Fintan will lead a group of fifty young people (18 to 30 years) to Rome this summer from the 28th July to the 4th August for **Jubilee of Youth Pilgrimage**. It is a once in a life opportunity for our young people to not only meet the Pope, to experience the Eternal City, but also to be encouraged and inspired as they meet other young people of faith from all continents. The pilgrimage will cost €550 per person (plus fundraising) and will include seven nights half board at the Irish College, Travel Insurance, a 20Kg bag, and a pilgrim kit.
