### The Rosary Beads.

Maria visited a care home for the elderly that was run by a Catholic association. One day she and a colleague called Roberta met Aldo, a tall, very cultured and very wealthy man. Aldo looked sternly at the two young women and said, 'Why do you always come here? What do you want from us? Why don't you just let us die in peace?' Maria didn't lose heart and told him, 'We are here for you, to spend some time together, to get to know each other and become friends.' They continued to visit the home regularly. Roberta recounts, 'That man was particularly closed in on himself and dejected. He did not believe in God.

Maria was the only one who was able to get close to him, gently listening to him for hours. She prayed for him and, on one occasion, gave him a rosary beads which he accepted.' Later, Maria learnt that he had spoken her name as he was dying. The pain of his death was lessened by the fact that he died peacefully, holding the rosary she had given him.
